The Rector of the Warsaw College of Engineering and Health invites all interested parties to apply for participation in the **International Online Study Visit**

1. Participant Requirements:

- academic title of a professor or academic degree of a habilitated doctor or academic degree of a doctor of sciences;
- declaration of employment at a higher education institution (minimum 5 years);
- professional experience and/or academic achievements in the field of the green transformation of the food production sector, including sustainable development, environmental efficiency, and alignment with EU policies;
- communicative competence of English, i.e. enabling free communication in an international environment.

The International Online Study Visit shall include:

- a) 1 representative of a Polish higher education institution,
- b) 2 representatives of foreign higher education institutions.

Academic teachers employed at the Warsaw College of Engineering and Health as their primary place of work are excluded from the application process.

2. Expected scope of works:

Participants of the **International Online Study Visit** will take part in meetings aimed at discussing the green transformation of the food production sector, using Poland and other European countries as examples.

3. Meeting dates: **March 2026 – April 2026**

4. Legal and formal information regarding the involvement: **the meetings referred to in point 2 shall take place with the use of ICT tools; meetings shall be held in English; the total number of meetings is 12 hours divided into 2 days 6 hours each. The dates of the meetings shall be agreed with all members of the International Online Study Visit and approved by the Project Manager.**

The remuneration for the members of the International Online Study Visit shall be paid on the basis of the civil law agreement, after the completion of the series of meetings [i.e. 2 days], including confirmation of attendance at each of them.

5. Individuals applying to participate in the International Online Study Visit are requested to submit the following documents:
 - written application – **form No. 1 enclosed to the announcement;**
 - a current resume confirming that the participant requirements referred to in point 1 have been met – **Appendix No. 1 to the application;**
 - a declaration of employment at a higher education institution (minimum 5 years);
 - authorisation to process personal data – **Appendix No. 2 to the application.**
6. The application with appendices should be:

7. Participants of the **International Online Study Visit** shall be selected on the basis of a formal verification of the submitted documentation, i.e. its completeness and correctness, as well as the candidate's fulfilment of the participant requirements referred to in point 1.
8. In the event that the number of applications exceeds the available number of places, the order of submission will determine the outcome.
9. Candidates will be notified of the results of the call by email on **2 March 2026.**

AUTHORISATION TO PROCESS PERSONAL DATA

1. The Warsaw College of Engineering and Health (registered at ul. Bitwy Warszawskiej 1920 No. 18, 02-366) is the Personal Data Controller. 2. Personal data shall be processed in order to carry out the contractor selection process.
3. Providing personal data is voluntary, but essential and necessary to carry out the process of selecting a participant of **the International Online Study Visit**. The applicant has the right to request from the Warsaw College of Engineering and Health access to personal data, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing, as well as the right to object to the processing and transfer of data.
